had a proper life on the road,
including regular tours around
Europe by it's previous
owners.

This "Royal" is in original
and unrestored condition and
is now MOT and Tax exempt.

The Bing carburetors
have been replaced by Amal MK2's
(often the case), and it's new
clamps have been renewed.

(All replaced parts are included
in the sale).

I have recently fitted a new
updated Starter Spragg Clutch, so now

Starts smoothly on the electric starter. (However, electric starter should never be used from cold.)

Comes complete with paperwork, manuals and related literature including an original sales brochure.

Has been sitting for some time so would benefit from a good tune-up!
